To be considered for an entry, each runner must commit to make a donation or raise funds totaling \$2,500 or more to the Inner City Handball Association which was established in 1991 as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, and your tax-deductible donations help Inner City Handball Association to continue to serve, educate and mentor New York City young people through the sport of Handball. Fundraising Commitment

A \$2,500 minimum fundraising donation is required to secure your guaranteed entry into the 2011 ING NYC Marathon.

The ICHA reserves the right to remove you from the race if the \$2,500 is not raised by 11:59 pm EST on November 1, 2011.

Cancellation Policy

You may cancel your participation with Team ICHA for the 2011 ING New York City Marathon any time on or before **September 13, 2011**. You must contact Jennifer Ramirez at the Inner City Handball Association in writing on or before the cancellation date. After August 20, 2011, you are responsible for raising the \$2,500 minimum, even if for any reason, including injury, you are unable to physically participate in the marathon.

Note: Donations raised and received by the Inner City Handball Association cannot be refunded, even if you cancel before September 13, 2011.
